

ICC receives 425 kg/hr CO₂ recovery plant order from Craft Brew Alliance

ICC in partnership with Haffmans was awarded a contract to supply a 425 kg/h carbon dioxide (CO₂) recovery system from Craft Brew Alliance, Inc.'s (CBA) Widmer Brothers Brewing Company in Portland, OR.

Pentair Haffmans will supply CO₂ recovery plant and ICC will provide turnkey project management and installation of the system at the brewery.

Pentair Haffmans CO₂ recovery systems recover CO₂ released during brewing fermentation for storage and use by the brewery. This reduces both the need to purchase bulk CO₂ from outside suppliers and greenhouse gas emissions, which aligns perfectly with CBA's in-house sustainability program.

Installation is planned for the fourth quarter of 2016.
